If you have any ideas for fun games that we can challenge each other with please let me know.



Pound Cake



Cream: 1 cup Butter
2 3/4 cups Sugar

Add Flour mixture alternating with 1 cup Sour Cream

Add: 6 slightly beaten eggs and mix well
1/2 tsp Lemon extract
1/2 Orange extract
1 tsp Vanilla

Bake at 350 for 45-60 minutes testing with knife

* Very good served with Berries and Cream or Lemon Curd

Sift together:
3 cups flour
1/2 tsp Salt
1/2 tsp Soda
