



I went to use an acrylic color I haven't used a lot of at least not out of this bottle and was frustrated all the boogers that came out. It wasn't a new bottle but was about 3/4 full. Then I remembered something I used in the past to still be able to use this paint. I miss the old L'eggs knee highs you used to be able to buy but any cheap stockings will do. I cut @ 3x3 square of the stocking....remove the lid of the paint bottle....stretch the square stocking over the bottle opening to create a filter and screw the lid back on. This should filter those boogers and give you smooth paint coming out of the bottle. Hope this helps those who haven't tried this.
