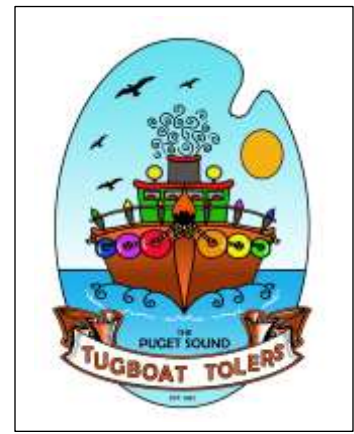

PAINT LIST (Decoart Americana) *Antique Rose, Deep Burgundy, Green Tea, Jade Green, Melon, Navy Blue, Payne's Grey, Persimmon, Plantation Pine, Prussian Blue, Snow White, Whispering Turquoise, Crystal Glamour Dust*

SPECIAL SUPPLIES: Surface - 10" snowflake (can be purchased at class for \$10.00 already basecoated with Whispering Turquoise)

You could also put on any surface and adjust your pattern to fit.

Monica will have 20 snowflakes available and ready to paint.

Surfaces will be purchased direct from Monica. Snowflake Stencil modeling paste if you would like textured snowflakes. Bring your

favorite brushes and several of the wedge shaped cosmetic sponges.

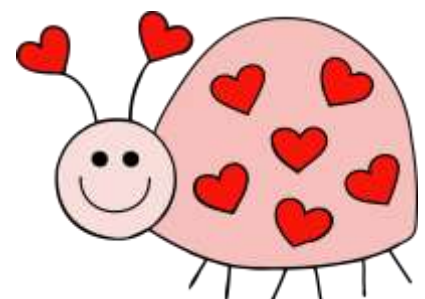
